## **Submission of Your Presentation Data**

### ■What to Submit

- ✓ Submit your presentation data of the break out session. It should be in <u>PDF</u> format,
- ✓ The WAC2016 Conference language is English, the data should be written in English,
- ✓ Please insert the following information on the first page or at the beginning of the presentation data.
  - -Name of conference (World Adhesive & Sealant Conference 2016)
  - -Names of presenters, name of company, name of department, titles, country name
  - -Category of presentation (Environment, Evolution, Creation, or Free)
  - -Title of presentation
  - -Names of authors, affiliated organizations, etc. (as needed)
- ✓ Keep the submitted data within 5MB.
- ✓ Keep the content of your slides to main points only.
- ✓ Keep any diagrams or charts simple.

### ■Regulations

You are kindly requested to obey the following rules:

- ✓ NO general company introduction\*1,
- ✓ NO company, trademark, brand or product names in your presentation\*2,
- ✓ Prove your point by being positive, do not speak adversely of your competitors.
  - \*1: Platinum, Gold, Silver, and Bronze sponsor companies are an exemption to this restriction. However, the introduction must be kept to max 1 slide.
  - \*2: Platinum, Gold, Silver, and Bronze sponsor companies are an exemption to this restriction.
- ✓ **DON'T** mention prices your company may charge customers.
- ✓ DON'T mention discounts, terms of conditions of sales, warranty terms, profits or profit margins, market shares, bids or the intention to bid, rejection or termination of customers, market sales territories.
- ✓ DON'T mention any proposal or any activity that may have the effect of producing an adverse economic impact on competing companies.

#### **■Notes for Your Presentation Data**

- ✓ The submitted data does not have to be the same presentation data that will be presented on the day of the conference. Please submit data that allows the contents of the conference presentation to be understood.
- ✓ Submitted data may be in essay format if the contents allow the contents of the conference presentation to be understood. However, please submit the data in PDF format.
- ✓ Before the conference, the submitted data can be viewed and downloaded from the WAC2016 official homepage (http://wac2016.org/). The date of uploading will be posted on the homepage at a latter date. Please note that we do not plan to distribute the submitted data and the presentation data to be used at the conference in printed format to the participants on the day of the conference.
- ✓ The WAC2016 Review Committee will ask you to adapt your presentation if the style is too commercial.
